Supporting and training employees as Horticultural Technician apprentices has always benefited companies as they receive a skilled, productive and loyal worker. Now, there are even more financial benefits for employers who invest in the apprenticeship program!

The Government of Ontario's <u>Achievement Incentive (AI) Grant</u> supports employers by providing a financial incentive when an apprentice meets specific milestones in their apprenticeship journey. The AI Grant aims to help both employers and apprentices by:

- · Offsetting hiring, on-boarding and training costs.
- · Attracting new hires and registering more apprentices, including those from underrepresented groups.
- Facilitating apprentice training progression, completion and certification.

As of April 1, 2022: Hort Tech 441C Employer Sponsors are now eligible to receive between \$3,000 to \$11,000 for each apprentice who achieves their milestones of the apprentice journey: registration, in-school training, and certification.

*Employers who hire and train a new youth apprentice who self-identifies as being from an underrepresented group will qualify for all payments for that milestone (e.g. Level 1 completion = \$3,000)!
